Linwood's St Benedict's High school is celebrating top SQA results.

Outstanding results in S4 saw 45 per cent of the year group achieving five or more National 5 awards while in S5, 19 per cent of pupils achieved 5 or more Highers – an 11 percentage point increase from 2017.

Headteacher Alan Taylor said:"Our young people, with the encouragement and support of teachers and parents, worked incredibly hard over the session to achieve these fantastic results.

"We're delighted for them. We know

how much effort our pupils have put in and it is extremely rewarding that so many have achieved such excellent results and will now go on to the next stage of their learning journey with confidence that they can achieve all they want to.
