Dear Parent / Carer

You will be aware of last week's announcement by the First Minister where she indicated of a potential return of more senior pupils (S4-6) to school from Monday 15th March.

She also indicated the return of S1-S3 pupils from 5th April. Please note, as this date falls within the school's Easter break, the return date would be Monday 19th April.

The proposals announced are subject to continued reductions in virus levels in the community. The First Minister will confirm these plans at the next review of coronavirus protective measures, which is expected on Tuesday 2nd March.

A key factor, crucial to our planning for this, is whether or not pupils will be required to socially distance to 2m whilst in the building. This decision will determine if pupils will return full time or part time. In the event of part time, remote learning experiences will be made available.

In order to provide detailed information about the session ahead, including SQA arrangements, I will be organising an online live meeting. Further details to follow.

Return to School

I am delighted to report a positive return to school last week. It was clear to see that pupils were enjoying being back in the building and continuing with their education. Across the week the majority of classes had 100% attendance with pupils responding well to our safety arrangements.
