An NPA or National 4 is awarded on a pass/fail basis, however we have used the following sliding scale to report on the quality of work being produced by pupils.

The **estimate grade** (shown as a working grade on the report) demonstrates the grade which the class teacher thinks your child is capable of if they work to their full potential. This grade is based on the assessment evidence that the school has for your child. To maintain or improve on these grades, pupils will need to apply themselves fully during study leave. Pupils may attend school, wearing full school uniform, to work in The Street area during study leave. Supported study days have also been organised for a number of subjects. These will give pupils the opportunity to work with staff, to go over key points and to get advice on how to approach the exam. These will be on the day before the SQA exam. This timetable has been shared with pupils and will be uploaded to our website.
