What are Assessment Arrangements?

- ▶ Assessment Arrangements (AAA) are supports provided to candidates with additional support needs to ensure fair access to SQA assessments.



Eligibility Criteria

AAA are available to pupils with:

- Specific learning difficulties
- Physical or sensory impairments
- Mental health conditions
- Other barriers to learning

- Scribe



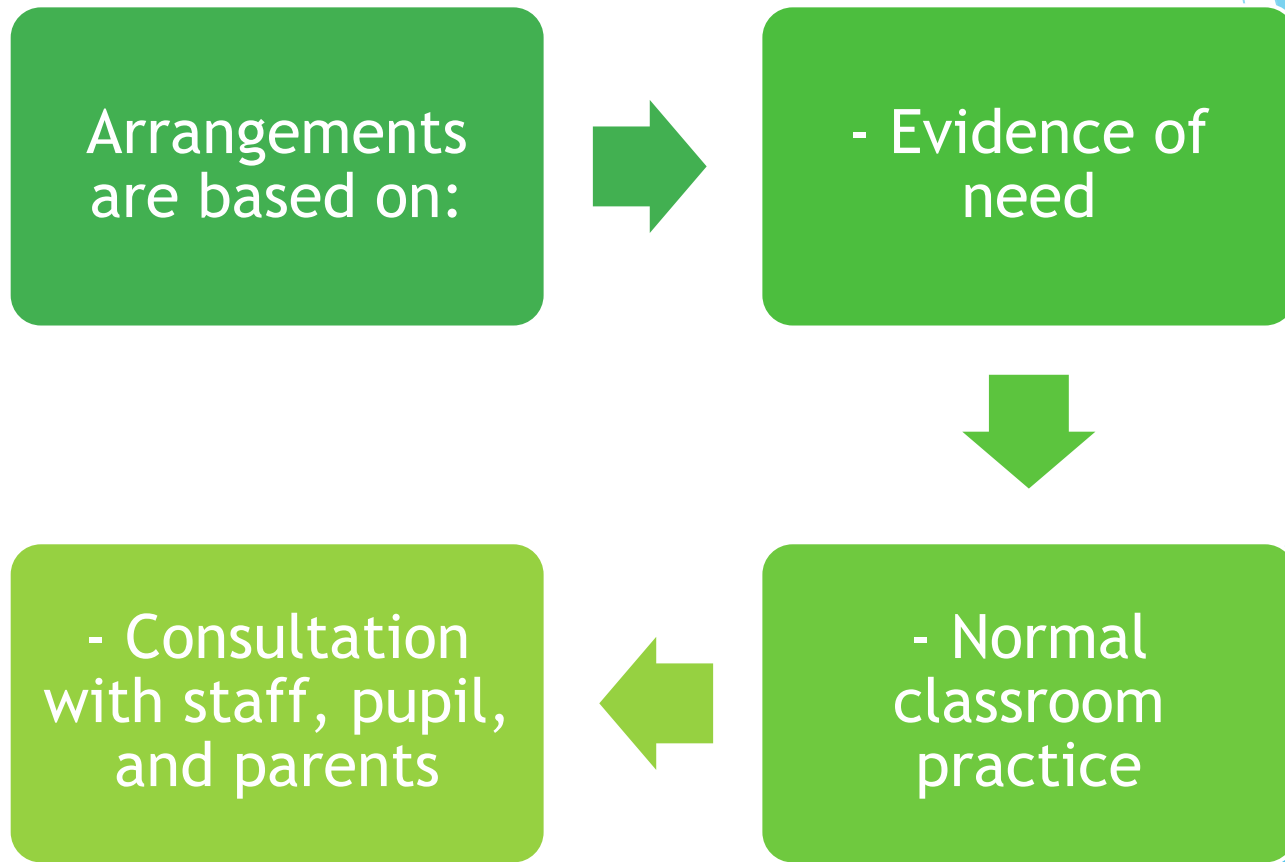
- Prompter

Role of Parents and Pupils

Parents and pupils are encouraged to:



- Share relevant information



- Support the implementation of arrangements



- Attend planning meetings



Timeline and Process



Key stages:



- Identification of need



- Gathering evidence



- Submitting arrangements to SQA



- Implementation during assessments



How to Request Assessment Arrangements

To request AAA for your child:

- Speak to your child's Guidance Teacher or Learning Support staff

- Provide any relevant documentation (e.g., medical reports, educational assessments)

- Attend planning meetings to discuss your child's needs

- Ensure requests are made early in the school year to meet SQA deadlines
